Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

As a building material reuse warehouse, TSP generally focuses on the need to reuse materials whenever we can. By reusing many building materials as TSP members and donors do, we are helping to reduce the amount of materials landfilled. Why bury that old door, when it is still perfectly good and someone else could really use it?

Other efforts that each of us can carry out include reducing the amount of waste we create, by analyzing purchases very carefully. Overpackaging is a generator of much waste, and adds to the price of the product. Look for the item with the least packaging, or for one that is in recycled packaging. Then make sure to recycle any parts of the packaging that are acceptable in our area.

Recycling is the third “R” of waste management. There are active programs throughout most of the counties TSP serves. We can recycle paper, paperboard and corrugated cardboard boxes, steel and aluminum cans, plastics with the code #1 or #2 on them, phone books, and glass bottles. Call Stark County Recycling at 330-451-7808 for Stark County information or to get the recycling number for other counties. Thanks for your reuse efforts; let’s work on the other “R’s” as well!

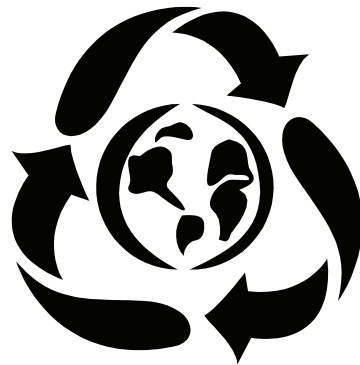

SUMMERTIME CHORE HINTS: from Stanley’s 250 Hints & Tips for Do-it-Yourselfers

- Want to fix that leaky garden hose? Spread rubber cement over the leak. Bend hose at crack to allow some glue to seep in, let dry. Reapply. After drying, wrap friction tape around crack.
- Avoid direct sunlight & wind when painting outdoors. The sun and/or wind will dry the paint too quickly. An ideal day would be overcast w/ temperatures between 60-90 degrees. Overcast days are also great days to wash windows.
- Roof leaking? Can’t find the hole? On the next sunny day go to your attic & look to see if any sunlight is visible through small holes in your roof. Nail through the hole w/ a long hole sized nail. This will help you find the hole when you get on the outside of the roof.
